More construction workers needed for I-4 Ultimate project



ORLANDO, Fla. — The \$2.3 billion, 21-mile I-4 Ultimate construction project makes many drivers want to veer onto a different road. But the project has another five years before it'll be completed.

"We're still slated to finish by 2021," said Loreen Bobo with the Florida Department of Transportation. However, construction is moving along.

To continue cruising, SGL Constructors are hiring. Jobs range from concrete finishers to heavy-equipment operators.

Before employees can operate a machine, they must pass a simulation test.

"So we know he can safely go out in the field and perform his work," said Bill Reed of SGL Constructors.

But applicants don't have to be experts.

"Say the guy is not totally up to par on it and needs training. We use that simulator to continue the training," said Reed.

The center is open Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays for those who want to apply.

In total, the I-4 Ultimate project will create up to 2,000 jobs.
